SPECTRUM UPDATE

The news photos of hundreds of cargo ships idling just outside Southern California ports help explain why the repairs and upgrades to LV's internet and television services promised by Spectrum are not moving forward on the schedule originally set by the corporation. Work here is at a standstill as the company waits for necessary parts. The underground upgrades are partially completed. But it's likely that this first part of the project will not be completed until early 2022.

By the new agreement with Spectrum, the upgrades will include internet (200/10 MBPS), a modem and a router, unlimited bandwidth, access to 274 TV channels, high-definition service, HBO and HBO Max, and two DVR boxes. According to the company, the basic charge to a household will total an estimated \$56 a month.
